The Sarcoma Foundation of America (SFA) advocates for sarcoma patients by funding research and by increasing awareness about sarcoma. SFA raises money to privately fund grants for sarcoma researchers and conducts education and advocacy efforts on behalf of sarcoma patients.

THE SPARK that ignited the start of the SFA in 2000, was the sarcoma diagnosis of then 3-year-old, Jeffrey Thornton. Jeffrey's parents, Dr. Mark and Patricia Thornton, along with physician, Dr. John Brooks, were motivated to act not only to help treat his cancer but others' as well. Grappling with Jeffrey's diagnosis, they found there wasn't a national patient advocacy and research organization dedicated to sarcoma patients and their families. They sought to fill that void.

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Through our humble beginnings, SFA has grown exponentially, and launched the first Race to Cure Sarcoma (RTCS) event in 2016. Race to Cure Sarcoma has now become the premier run/walk series in the United States, focused on raising awareness and research funds for sarcoma. Events take place in major cities across the nation, bringing together patients, survivors, families, caregivers, and medical professionals.


Approximately 15% of sarcomas are found in a metastatic stage and the **5-year survival rate is 16**%
